



Traveling EdZOOcation Programs

CLASSROOM PROGRAMS • BOOTH PRESENTATIONS

During our Traveling EdZOOcation programs groups learn about wildlife biology and ecology through up-close encounters with our Animal Ambassadors.

Each classroom program lasts approximately 30 minutes and is limited to participation by **no more than 25 individuals per session**. Programs may be adapted for all age groups.

The New York State Zoo at Thompson Park is proud to present educational programming that meets New York State curriculum standards. Each program includes educational presentations with age-appropriate discussions, concluded with opportunities for Q/A and direct connection with our Animal Ambassadors.

BRIM (pre-2)

Birds, Reptiles, Invertebrates, Mammals

These groups will compare/contrast 4 characteristics of each type of animal including thermoregulation, fur/scales, eggs/live birth, hands-on/hands-off parenting.

Wild Wonders (grades 3-5)

These groups will learn about species characteristics, natural behaviors, and how we are all connected through the balance of ecosystems.

Creature Culture (grades 6-8)

These groups will learn about animal adaptations, predator/prey relationships, and conservation initiatives.

Booth Presentations are ideal for educational festivals, corporate events, science fairs, company picnics, environmental events, and more! These presentations include a table display with informative materials about the Zoo, biofacts such as furs & skulls for participants to explore, and 2-3 animal ambassadors for everyone to learn about and meet up close!

Events that are strictly entertainment themed will not include the use of live animals, as these types of events pose safety concerns for both the public and the animal ambassadors. For these types of events we will substitute our animal ambassadors for an engaging activity such as our Wildlife Trivia game.
